

The Johnson City Council met in regular session on Wednesday, April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2026 at 12:00pm at City Hall with Mayor Bryan Ellis presiding. Council members present were Clayton Winger, Andrew German, Seth Nelson, and Bret Kendrick. City clerk Kenna Rohrenback, city superintendent Tyce McMillan, and city attorney Clint Floyd were also present. Guests present were gubernatorial candidate Stacy Rogers, and local citizen Liaz Sanchez.

March 4<sup>th</sup> minutes were reviewed. Bret Kendrick moved to approve the minutes with corrections. Seth Nelson seconded and the motion carried 4-0.

March 10<sup>th</sup> minutes were reviewed. Bret Kendrick moved to approve the minutes with corrections. Andrew German seconded and the motion carried 4-0.

March bills were presented for approval. Clayton Winger moved to approve the bills as presented. Seth Nelson seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Several building permits were presented to Council for approval: 103 N Frontage #1 to install a mobile home; 305 S Stanton to install a shed; the east baseball field for installation of a batters' eye; the walking path to plant new trees; and at 404 N Chestnut to replace sidewalks and curbing. Bret Kendrick moved to approve the permits as presented and Andrew German seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Stacy Rogers met with Council and answered questions concerning her race for Kansas governor.

A quote for concrete replacement and repair was presented for approval. Bret Kendrick moved to approve the quote from S&R Construction for \$4200.00 for repairs to Ellsworth Street, the corner of Stanton and Logan to add a ramp, and repairs to West Greenwood North Avenue. Andrew German seconded and the motion carried 4-0.

Discussion concerning the service deposit and fee policy were tabled for a future meeting.

Resolution 2026-01 was presented for approval to move the City of Johnson City to KCAMP pool insurance.

**RESOLUTION 2026-01**

**OF City of Johnson City, STATE OF KANSAS**

(Municipality)

WHEREAS, the undersigned Municipality, has authority under the Kansas Municipal Group-Funded Pool Act, K.S.A. 12-2616, et seq., as amended, to participate in and form a municipal self-insurance pool for the insurance coverage for certain liabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality has reviewed an agreement to cooperate with other Municipalities to form such a self-insurance pool entitled "Fourth Amended and Restated Bylaws and Interlocal

Cooperation Agreement for the Kansas County Association Multiline Pool" ("KCAMP")

Motion was made by Bret Kendrick to approve the resolution, with Seth Nelson seconding. Motion carried 4-0.

Superintendent Tyce McMillan had several updates for Council: the well by Eagle was pulled, and L&N Pump was performing repairs on it as it hasn't had any updates for 13 years; we are waiting for growth on trees to see which ones need to be followed up on; Loren Wright is currently surveying lots on the east side of town for deeds; Earls' Engineering has done work for design on the new sewer main for east Ellsworth Avenue; the new water fill station is complete and operational, but the laptop for data transfer stopped working.

The next Council meeting is set for regular schedule on Wednesday, May 6th, 2026 at 12:00pm at City Hall.

There being no further business to discuss, meeting was adjourned.
