**ORDINANCE NO. 402**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 401 RELATING TO THE RENEWABLE PARALLEL GENERATION POLICY AND ELECTRIC RATE SCHEDULE.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF JOHNSON CITY, STANTON COUNTY, KANSAS:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.**

Ordinance No. 401, Section 2. Application is revised as follows:

- a) Service under this Renewable Parallel Generation Rate Schedule is available to City of Johnson City (“Utility”) customers in good standing with a Customer-owned renewable electric Generation Facility as defined in the Interconnection Standards for Installation and Parallel Operation of Customer-owned Renewable Electric Generation Facilities 25 kW<sub>AC</sub> or less for Residential Customers and 200 kW<sub>AC</sub> or less for Commercial Customers that wish to receive a billing credit for surplus renewable energy supplied to the Utility subject to the terms and conditions of this Schedule. Customer-owned renewable generation and associated equipment are collectively referred to as a Generation Facility.
- b) Utility may refuse interconnection of any generating facility with a rated generating capacity greater than Customer’s annual peak electric demand or greater than the Customer’s annual energy requirement.

**SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage, approval, and publication in the official city newspapers, all as provided by law.
